
Memorials or Special Occasion Tributes

Your gift to the Friends of the Shorewood Public Library commemorates an important person or occasion. A custom *bookplate* featuring your honoree's name will be placed inside a new book in the library.





How it works:

- Choose the friend, family member, or honoree to recognize.
- Make your gift online or in person at the Shorewood Public Library: Donation of \$20 for a children's book, \$50 for an adult book. Your gift is tax-deductible to the extent allowable by law. Friends of the Shorewood Public Library is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.
- The Friends of the Shorewood Public Library sends you a confirmation letter.
- The Friends of the Shorewood Public Library sends an *optional* letter, complete with your bookplate image, to the person or family you are honoring to announce your gift. *The amount is not disclosed.*
- Within two to three weeks, a bookplate is placed inside a new book in the Shorewood Public Library's adult or children's collection, as you have selected.

Your donation supports:

- A total of 80% of your gift supports additions to the library collections, and 20% supports popular annual programs and special community events.
