GROWN-UP TAKE & MAKE

WINE CORK PUMPKIN

WHAT YOU NEED:

- 25 corks
- Hot glue gun (preferred) or other glue
- Synthetic leaf, wired twine, or anything else you'd like to use for added decoration.

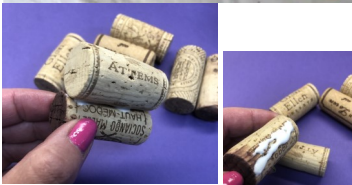
- **NOTE:** A hot glue gun is the quickest way to bind your corks, but in case you don't have one we've provided some tacky glue. Using the tacky glue requires a little more patience & drying time between layers!

HOW-TO:

1. Arrange the corks in rows (4 on the bottom, then 5, then 6, then 5 and 4 on the top row) and glue them together**. Wait for them to dry before further assembly.

**For best results, try to match up the corks so they're the same length in each row.

1. Glue a row of 5 on top of a row of 4, Wait for glue to dry before attaching next layer, then glue a row of 6 on top of the row of 5, then another row of 5, topped with the last row of 4.
2. Take the one remaining cork and glue it on top as the stem.
3. Twist the wired twine around a pencil to create a curly vine look and attach it to the top of your pumpkin. Glue leaf and berries around the stem.
